MILES CITY, MONTANA: Each year at Miles Community College, distinguished graduating student awards are given to three MCC students based on the individual's time as a student, including their academic and co-curricular involvement. These awards are presented at graduation ceremonies and are given in three divisions: General/Arts and Sciences, Career and Technical, and Nursing. Nominations are submitted in the spring by MCC faculty and staff.

This year, the Class of 2024 Outstanding Graduate in the General/Arts and Sciences division is Rylee Deming of Colstrip, Montana. Deming will be graduating *summa cum laude* with an Associate of Arts degree in the Education Pathway program at this Saturday's graduation ceremony on campus.

Deming is an active and engaged student leader, serving as a Resident Assistant in the residence halls on campus for the 2023-2024 year and participating in programs sponsored by the Student Activities Board. She also teaches at Let Me Shine Preschool in Miles City.
