<u>MILES CITY, MONTANA</u>: In conjunction with workforce development, Miles Community College is hosting its annual Teacher's Institute classes.

The Teacher's Institute will offer professional development courses in July with both credit and OPI renewal units available.

On July 8 and 9, Kim Smith will be teaching the Deconstructing Distance Learning course. Class members will be sharing unique experiences with distance learning and the struggles and successes that occurred during the coronavirus pandemic. Information on resources, tolls, and strategies will be available for lesson delivery and online collaboration.
